RHA Accepting Referrals for MAJORS Program

CONCORD, NC – PBH is pleased to announce that RHA Health Services, Inc., is accepting referrals for the MAJORS Program in the PBH catchment of Cabarrus, Davidson, Rowan, Stanly and Union counties. MAJORS is a program geared toward youth who are involved in the juvenile court system. To be eligible for the program, the juvenile must be involved with the Department of Juvenile Justice and have, or be suspected of having, a substance abuse issue. All referrals to the program are made through a Department of Juvenile Justice Court Counselor.

The MAJORS Program is a partnership of agencies that combines court requirements, sanctions and rewards, and community services with substance abuse treatment for juvenile offenders. MAJORS provides opportunities for youth to receive accessible, responsive, and coordinated community substance abuse

treatment services directed toward changing behaviors and sustaining the positive gains made in treatment.

Participants in the program will be enrolled for six to 12 months.

RHA, of Cleveland, NC, is one of four PBH Comprehensive Community Providers, and delivers services to consumers in the PBH five-county area. RHA will manage, provide and coordinate screening, assessment and treatment services for youth. The company was awarded the MAJORS contract in the Spring.
