## A Resource for Law Enforcement

The Crisis Recovery Center offers help to people who are experiencing a mental health crisis, or who need medical detox from drugs or alcohol in a non-hospital environment. It is NOT an ER or private hospital. **The program seeks to help people avoid unnecessary psychiatric hospitalization in acute or state hospital settings.** As a law enforcement officer, you can: 1. Refer people to the program; 2. Bring people to the program; or 3. Call the program for help in making referral decisions.

## Talking to People about the Crisis Recovery Center:

As a police officer, you can suggest Crisis Recovery Center as a resource to help deal with crisis and avoid the hospital emergency room. Let people know that it is not a hospital, and that they can leave at any time (if they are voluntary clients). Staff will help the person through the crisis and follow-up care.

**Who this program is for:** Individuals living in Cabarrus, Davidson, Rowan, Stanly and Union counties, age 18 and older, who are having a mental health crisis, alcohol or substance abuse problem. We also serve individuals with developmental disabilities who are experiencing a mental health or substance abuse crisis. We assess persons on petition (please call ahead). We **cannot** accept people with medical emergencies, or people with extremely violent tendencies.
