Facility-Based Crisis Stabilization & Non-Hospital Medical Detox

A community-based program that exists to help people deal with crises and avoid unnecessary psychiatric hospitalization in acute or state hospital settings.

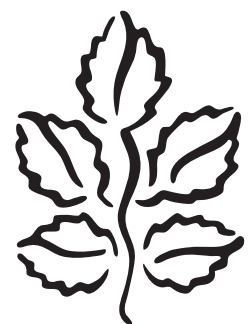
