RE: Residential Supports Bed Size Interpretation

With the effective date of this communication:

- The maximum residential facility (site) size for individuals who are new to the Innovations waiver will increase from three (3) to six (6) beds.
- Persons currently receiving services through the waiver may live in residential facilities with a licensed capacity of six (6) beds or less.
- Residential facilities with existing licensure capacity of six (6) beds or less are eligible to join the PBH Network.
- New residential facilities, defined as new construction or newly licensed, must have a licensure capacity of three (3) beds or less.

Changes are based on the amendment to the NC Innovations waiver submitted to CMS by the Division of Medical Assistance.
