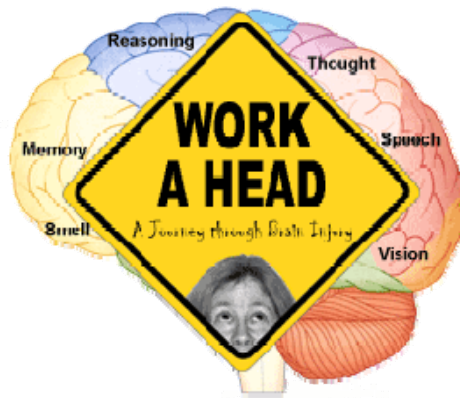

Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Workshop

Workshop Description:

This workshop will assist the participant with developing an understanding of what traumatic brain injury is, the unique difficulties individuals with TBI experience, suggested compensatory strategies for TBI related difficulties, and community resources.
